## Articles

## 1. Year 6 Trip:

Year 6 had a fantastic trip to Burnham Beeches on Tuesday morning. We were met by 2 of the rangers who shared their knowledge of how the Beeches was used during WW2 along with some super photos of how it looked when it was requisitioned by the war office and used as a vehicle depot. The children were then shown some of the remains of the buildings that were erected at that time as well as the remains of telephone wires which are still visible in some of the trees.

The visit was then brought to life through the augmented reality app that was launched by the Corporation of London last year. It was fascinating to be able to see how the area that we were standing in looked during WW2. We then walked back to school, passing the site of a battery store, machine gun dugouts and brick paths that were used for the storage of large vehicles during the war in preparation for the D-Day landings. The children gained a lot of knowledge and really enjoyed their visit.





## 2. Junior Santa Dash:

Farnham Common Junior School is hosting a "just for fun" and "because it's Christmas" Santa Dash on Friday 6<sup>th</sup> December. This will take place during the school at a time to suit the timetable of each year group. The Santa Dash will take place on the School field and where staff will have set up fun, winter-themed obstacles for the children to work their way through.

All we ask from you:
