The five oceans are the Pacific, Atlantic, Indian, Southern and Arctic.


The seven continents are Asia, Africa, North America, South America, Antarctica, Europe and Oceania.

South Pole	The southernmost point on planet Earth which is located within Antarctica.
Antarctica	The southernmost continent which is the coldest place on Earth.
The Sahara	A desert on the continent of Africa. It is the largest hot desert in the world.
